REPRINTS AND WESITES

Enclosed with this issue of the Newsletter are reprints of four older papers by Busck (1906), Clarke (1962) and Powell (1963, 1965). The reprints formerly were stored in the basement of the National Museum of Natural History. However, during recent "clean-up" activities they were identified as items to be discarded. I thought they might be discarded best in your direction.

Also enclosed is a reprint of the most recent paper by Brown (2003) (*New Euliini genera*), along with the first page of a paper published earlier this year by Brown and Adamski (2003) (revision of *Anopinella*). For a free copy of the latter (94 pages), go to the Zootaxa website (<http://www.mapress.com/zootaxa>) from which it can be downloaded and printed (warning - it takes a while to print!). Once on the website, click on "browse online issues" and then "browse by author." That will give you an alphabetic listing of authors. Scroll down until you come to Brown and Adamski, and print from there. Also available on the web via PDF are a recent paper by Byun and Yan (2001) (<http://www.alric.org/entomology/KJAE/40/404273.pdf>) and a paper by Razowski (2001) (<http://sinica.edu.tw/zool/zoolstud/39.4/319-327.pdf>) on the Tortricidae of Taiwan. You will need Adobe Acrobat to download these papers, but it is free on the web.

Other recently posted items of interest on the web are Tod Gilligan's site (<http://www.tortricid.net>), with hundreds of photographs of North American Tortricidae, and a site featuring Jozef Razowski's impressive bibliography and list of described taxa (<http://www.isez.pan.krakow.pl/staff/jraz.htm>). STATUS OF THE CATALOG OF TORTRICIDAE OF THE WORLD

In April of this year I launched a major (and I hope final) effort to try and complete the catalog of the Tortricidae of the world, which includes between 8,900 and 9,000 recognized species. I enlisted the assistance of several specialists worldwide, primarily those affiliated with institutions which house the greatest number of tortricid types. We hope to finish the work by the end of the year (2003) and make the catalog available by mid-2004. The hard-copy version may be published by the Wedge Entomological Foundation, but that is still uncertain. All the included names likely will be available on the web via the Global Lepidoptera Names Index centered at The Natural History Museum, London.
